



Introduction

The **World of Outlaws Morton Buildings Late Model Championship Series** is the highest level dirt late model series in iRacing. Drivers who have reached this series are the best virtual dirt late model drivers in the world. This series is limited to iRacing members who have reached a specific level of competitiveness and qualified in through the World of Outlaws Morton Buildings Qualifying Series.

This document outlines the qualification process, race format, schedule, general series rules and series prizes. It is meant as a guidebook for iRacing members already competing in this series and for those wishing to qualify to do so.

This guide, together with the [Official Sporting Code](#), [Terms of Use and End User License Agreement](#), [iRacing.com Motorsport Simulations, LLC Privacy Policy](#) and [Online Competitions and Contests Official Contest Rules](#) form the body of rules and procedures applicable to all iRacing members and all iRacing events, including the World of Outlaws Morton Buildings Late Model Championship Series (collectively, the “iRacing Rules”).

Each member is required to read, understand and agree to all iRacing Rules prior to participation in any World of Outlaws Morton Buildings Late Model Championship Series event. The iRacing Rules form a contract between each iRacing member and iRacing.com Motorsport Simulations, LLC. An iRacing member may accept the iRacing Rules by accepting the click-through terms on iRacing.com, or registering to participate (or participating) in any World of Outlaws Morton Buildings Late Model Championship Series event.



Qualifying Series

The World of Outlaws Morton Buildings Late Model Qualifying Series will be the sole qualifying series for entry into the **World of Outlaws Morton Buildings Late Model Championship Series**. This series will run as the standard Super Late Model series during 2019 Season 2.

- Qualifying series is open to Dirt Oval C 4.0 License and up
- This series will run every 2 hours and score the best 8 out of 12 weeks
- Races may have multiple splits based on iRating
- Races will utilize Heat Racing
- Standard 12 week series with 4 drop weeks
- Grid positions will be determined by qualifying
- Qualifying will be attached to the race session
- In 2019 - Top 20 points finishers who aren't already qualified will be considered for a Pro/WC license and entry into the **World of Outlaws Morton Buildings Late Model Championship Series**
- In the event that a driver that is top 20 in points is not eligible for any reason, the spot will go to the next available points position. (Example 21st, 22nd, etc)



WoO LM Championship Series Overview

20 drivers earn licenses to compete in the **World of Outlaws Morton Buildings Late Model Championship Series** through the **Qualifying Series**. 15 drivers retain their licenses from the **World of Outlaws Morton Buildings Late Model Championship Series**. All 35 drivers will compete to be crowned the World Champion.

Once a member earns a **World of Outlaws Morton Buildings Late Model World Championship Series** license, he or she shall retain that license for the entire season so long as the driver maintains a safety rating of 1.0 or higher at that license class. If a driver falls below a 1.0 safety rating, their WCS license is temporarily suspended, however, that driver can drive at the lower class levels and may regain their World Championship licenses by achieving a 4.0 or higher safety rating. A driver could also permanently or temporarily lose their license for race incidents or other actions deemed detrimental to the series.



WoO Late Model Championship Series

Field Size

- 35 cars max
 - Race grids will be determined by qualifying
 - Heat racing will be utilized
 - 4 heats, 8 laps—top 4 advance to final from each heat
 - 2 consolation races, 10 laps-top 4 advance to final from each
- *Up to 15 drivers will not make the final
- Feature race
 - 20 drivers, 50 laps

WoO Morton Buildings LM Championship Season

- To participate in this series, participants may be required to submit and have approved the follow: W9 form, Bio (utilizing our template), headshot (utilizing our criteria)
- 10 week season with no drops
- Races are every other Tuesday at 00:45 GMT / Monday 08:45 pm ET
- Top 15 in points at the end of the season will retain their WCS license.
- Competitors must compete in 7 of the 10 races to be eligible to return to the series the following season.



WoO Craftsman LM Championship Series

Race Review

- Every race will be reviewed by the Race Director live and/or through replay/broadcasts
- iRacing may take action against a driver for rules infractions or any action deemed detrimental to the series including but not limited to points adjustments, suspension or other penalties.

Protests

- Drivers may file a protest to the Race Director (race.director@iracing.com) with a detailed description and a replay for review
- Offenses may result in suspension or termination from the series
- A driver who is suspended based on incidents in this series may or may not also be suspended from iRacing.

Appeals

- Only a driver that has been penalized may appeal a decision.
- A driver may appeal a protest decision by e-mailing race.director@iracing.com with details on why they think the wrong decision has been made
- iRacing may take up to 7 days to rule on any appeals
- Appeals are reviewed by the appeal board which is independent of the race director.
- All decisions are final

Note: Drivers must be in good standing (not suspended from the series or the iRacing service) at the end of the season in order to be eligible for any prizes.



WoO LM Championship Series Prizes

Payment of Championship Prizes

Unless otherwise agreed between an iRacing member and his/her team, all championship earnings will be paid directly to the iRacing member who won the championship prize at the end of the season. Upon request by a team that employs an iRacing member, and with the consent of the iRacing member, iRacing will pay championship earnings directly to such team but only if the team (a) provides documentary evidence to iRacing that unambiguously authorizes such payment, (b) indemnifies, defends and holds harmless iRacing from competing claims for championship prizes, (c) submits the affidavit of eligibility and other documentation specified below and (d) provides any specific documents and materials iRacing deems needed or appropriate for iRacing.com to comply with all tax reporting and withholding requirements, which for non-U.S. members or teams, may include an affidavit from the member or team, as applicable, that confirms such person or team is not a U.S. person and that such prize is not related to commercial activity in the United States.

Each prize winner will receive confirmation of his/her prize, with instructions on how to claim the prize, via email sent to the email address associated with his/ her membership within ten days after the season ends. Each winner (or a team acting on behalf of a winner) may be required to sign and return an affidavit of eligibility, liability waiver and publicity/intellectual property release within ten days of the date of winning notification. If a winner (or a team acting on behalf of a winner) is found to have violated any of the iRacing Rules, is otherwise disqualified, cannot be reached, or fails to take all actions required to claim the prize within the times specified, that winner will forfeit the prize and an alternate winner may be selected by iRacing. Winners will be announced as soon as feasible after all winners have been qualified.

A driver must be in good standing at the season end to be eligible for any prizes (i.e., not suspended).

Driver Expectations

Drivers will be invited to **World of Outlaws Morton Buildings Late Model Championship Series** based on their competitive results and being a positive member of the iRacing community, as determined by iRacing. Drivers are required to represent the series and their team in a positive fashion in order to maintain their Pro and World Championship licenses. There is a very high level of competition and high community profile in this series; consequently, there are multiple additional conduct rules above and beyond the normal that exist only at this level. It is expected that each driver in this series will treat other drivers, teams, iRacing officials, employees, sponsors and the community with respect on and off the race track and will not bring the sport or iRacing into disrepute via their actions. The iRacing.com FIRST Sporting Code is in full effect for these series as applicable.

Driver Bio

In order to properly market the series, we may require that all competitors must submit a current Bio Summary to include a headshot and a car image.

Drivers may not be allowed to compete in the series without this submission. Anyone with questions regarding this policy is asked to email Race.Director@iracing.com with their concerns.



WoO LM Championship Series Rules

Series Age Restriction

- ♦ In order to register for the Sim, you must be an adult according to the laws of the jurisdiction (i.e. state or country, as the case may be) in which you reside. If you are not an adult but at least 13 years old, and if you wish to use the Sim and Race in this Series you must have a parent or guardian register for the Sim on your behalf and then agree and sign the Parental Consent Release.
- ♦ We require every member to be at least 13 years old to use iRacing.
- ♦ If you are at least 13 and not an adult according to the laws of your jurisdiction, your parent must sign the attached Consent and return it to Tyler.Hudson@iracing.com if you race in this Series
- ♦ In any event, the Sim is not designed for minors under the age of 13, so minors under the age of 13 are not permitted to use the Sim or Race in this Series under any condition. Again, If you wish the minor over 13 years of age to use the sim and race in this series, please see the attached Consent.
